N-DAY for State Poll

NOMINATION DAY WEDNESDAY MARCH 6

Nominations opened this week for the March 23 NSW State election and close next Wednesday March 6 at 12 noon.

Political pundits and the latest public opinion polls indicate a close call with the possibility of a hung parliament and a mixed bag Upper House result.

Close attention will be given to two vital seats in TWT Territory which could be decisive in the final wash up, namely Ryde and Lane Cove

Both are currently held by senior Liberal Party Ministers in the Berejiklian Coalition Government, namely Victor Dominello in Ryde and Anthony Roberts in Lane Cove.

And both have formidable contestants for their seats: current Ryde mayor Jerome Laxale for Labor in Ryde and former Hunters Hill mayor Richard Quinn as an Independent in Lane Cove.
