

Council to consider webcast

HUNTER'S Hill Council is looking to implement the live streaming of meetings from the start of 2018.

Councillor Zac Miles introduced a motion at the council meeting on Monday night to commence live streaming in November.

However this was turned down 4-2 in favour of an alternative motion put forward by councillor Ross Williams.

Mr Williams' motion requested council staff compile a report on the intricacies of the installation of live streaming services before a formal vote is made at the next council meeting on November 13.

"Transparency has been a mantra of mine and will continue to be throughout my tenure on council," Mr Williams said.

"I would like to know what the cost is and what meetings specifically are made available through this process."

Should council decide to go ahead with the live streaming, the service would commence from the first meeting next year.
